

CALL FOR EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST

Curriculum Consultant: Relationship Violence in Trans and Gender Diverse Communities

Contract Summary:

The Ending Violence Association of BC's (EVA BC) [Safe Choices LGBT2SQ Support and Education Program](#), in partnership with [Trans Care BC](#) (Provincial Health Services Authority) and [Prism Services](#) (Vancouver Coastal Health), is seeking expressions of interest for a curriculum consultant to (1) enhance an existing LGBT2SQ relationship violence training curriculum for service providers, and (2) develop a curriculum for a healthy relationship workshop for trans and gender diverse individuals, drawing on existing LGBT2SQ workshop curricula. The project is funded by Vancouver Coastal Health, and aims to enhance the Safe Choices workshop curricula to better reflect the experiences and needs of trans and gender diverse survivors of relationship violence and abuse.

The successful candidate will have knowledge of gender-based violence (especially intimate partner violence), be knowledgeable about the needs of trans and gender diverse survivors, and have research, curriculum development, and/or training/facilitation experience. The successful candidate will work with EVA BC's Safe Choices Program Coordinator and Assistant Coordinator, as well as project partners from Trans Care BC and Prism Services.

Commitment and Compensation: Compensation will be \$1,550 for a total of approx. 45 hours of work, to be completed by March 31, 2018. Work will be carried out at the EVA BC offices in downtown Vancouver and/or off-site, and the schedule can generally be flexible around the needs of the selected consultant. The consultant may have an opportunity to continue working with the Safe Choices program as a contracted workshop facilitator following completion of the project.

We value a wide range of experience, including volunteer and community experience. We strongly encourage BIPOC (Black, Indigenous, People of Colour) folks to submit expressions of interest. Strong preference will be given to folks who identify as transgender, non-binary, or Two-Spirit. If you feel comfortable, please share how you identify in your expression of interest.
