
## **ICAT Process Flow Chart**

A risk management plan is formulated and liaisons are assigned for both the victim/ survivor and offender.

If the case is before the court, the police co-chair will liaise with Crown Counsel and provide relevant information as required.

Case is reviewed at regular ICAT meetings with relevant updates and to assess whether risk factors have shifted. Risk management and safety plan is updated accordingly.

An ICAT file is closed when risk is reduced.

A risk management plan is formulated and the case continues to be monitored by the agencies who are actively involved with the victim/survivor or offender.

Information sharing does not occur with the ICAT in association to a non-designated case.

If risk escalates, case is re-referred to the ICAT for review.
